Listen up Brisbane, it's time for Listen Out

More than 20,000 people are expected to attend Australia's primary dance music festival Listen Out at the Brisbane Showgrounds this Saturday.

The multi-stage festival is touring a dynamic hip-hop/electronic lineup of almost 30 international and Australian acts, headlined by British rapper 21 Savage and American DJ John Summit.

For the first time, the festival is opening its doors to music fans aged 16 years and over, instead of its usual 18+ crowd.

Around 280 Brisbane Showgrounds staff will be working at the event to cater for the large crowds, including in the bars, non-alcoholic bars and food outlets.

Brisbane Showgrounds General Manager of Venue Sales and Marketing Jago Coyle said Listen Out was the first event kicking off the venue's spring/summer music festival season.

"We have many large-scale music festivals taking place over the next few months including Good Things Festival and Wildlands in December," Mr Coyle said.

"We've been hosting Listen Out since 2014 and look forward to once again welcoming incredible artists from Australia and overseas to our venue, along with tens of thousands of music fans."

Listen Out's Brisbane show features during the final weekend of the festival's Australian and New Zealand tour.

Gates open at midday with tickets still available online.
