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## A slam dunk of basketball talent on display at the Brisbane Showgrounds

Some of the best basketball players from across Australia and overseas will shoot for the stars at the Brisbane Showgrounds from this Friday at the PLAYGRND Showdown FIBA 3x3 Quest Final.
