Fans ready to rock for Knotfest at the Brisbane Showgrounds

This Sunday, heavy metal music fans will take over the Brisbane Showgrounds for the popular music festival Knotfest.

Returning for the third time to the Brisbane Showgrounds, the popular destination festival curated by iconic American band Slipknot will welcome 20,000 festival goers.

Knotfest is known for its iconic heavy metal music and counterculture experience. Along with the headliners Slipknot, the line-up includes A Day to Remember, Babymetal, Slaughter to Prevail, Polaris, Within Temptation, Enter Shikari, Hatebreed, In Hearts Wake, Health, Miss May I, Vended and Sunami.

This year Knotfest will also see the elevated return of the fan favourite Knotfest Museum. The museum will unveil iconic items throughout Slipknot's 25 year defining career including new activations, photo opportunities and experiences that immerse the audience into Slipknot's history.

Brisbane Showgrounds General Manager of Venue Sales and Marketing Jago Coyle said the popular music festival would wrap up a successful summer of music at the Brisbane Showgrounds.

"We're thrilled to welcome Knotfest back to the Brisbane Showgrounds for the third time," Mr Coyle said.

"This festival season we've welcomed almost 150,000 people to the Showgrounds for Listen Out, Good Things, Wildlands and a sold-out St Jerome's Laneway Festival, which featured a performance from British pop star Charli XCX.

"The successful summer of music will wrap up this weekend when we host 20,000 heavy metal fans for Knotfest."

Gates for Knotfest festival open at 11:30am this Sunday, with tickets still available online.
